Activity Outline



Activity Name: A Roundabout Way

Principle:

Sober drivers Avoiding risks Safe speeds Driving to the conditions No distractions

Building experience

Summary: Create a series of large roundabout simulations at school (could use chalk, cones, props etc). Make them vary in terms of difficulty – include both simple one-lane roundabouts and more complex multi-lane roundabouts.

Run a lunchtime session giving students the opportunity to practice using these roundabouts in order to familiarise themselves with the rules of driving around roundabouts. If possible, invite a local driving instructor to help run the session

Notes:

Before running this session, hold an assembly to talk about the activity and introduce how to safely use roundabouts. You could also run a Kahoot quiz to find out what the students already know and to find out where the knowledge gaps are.

Follow up the activity with another assembly or classroom session to debrief and provide resources for ongoing learning about the rules of roundabouts
