Activity Name: Believe it or not

Principle:

Sober drivers

Safe speeds

No distractions

Avoiding risks

Driving to the conditions

Building experience

Summary: This is an interactive quiz game that can be played in a classroom environment or in an assembly. Instruct everyone to stand up and ask them a question that relates to your chosen road safety topic (e.g. Driving to the Conditions). Give two options for the answer and instruct players to put their hands on their forehead for one answer or place hands on the back of their hips for the other answer (heads or tails). The players who answer correctly stay standing for the next questions, while the players who are wrong sit down and are out of the game
