Activity Name: Guess the ticket

Principle:

Sober drivers Safe speeds No distractions

Avoiding risks Driving to the conditions Building experience

Summary:

A lot of students aren't aware or don't care about the consequences of not following their license conditions. This activity reminds students that breaking the law has a cost, financially and in demerit points. It can also affect career pathways.

There are several ways you can run this activity; as an online quiz, as a game show, or as a mix and match activity.

Game Show plan:

- Get 2 students (or groups) on stage with a different buzzer sound each
- Place the list of infringements and the list of demerit points up on a projector
- Read out the rules: "Each infringement is worth different amounts of demerit points. If you get it wrong you get that many demerit point. At the end the team with the least demerit points wins! If you hit 100 demerit points you automatically lose.
- We recommend revealing the correct answers as you go so that the students learn something from the activity!

Put up the list of infringements and either the Demerit points or Shopping items, but make sure you mix them up! See below for the game-show table.

Infringement	Demerit Points	Shopping Items
Speeding by 10kmph or less	10	\$30 Apple headphones
2. Speeding 11-15kmph over the limit	20	\$80 New jeans/clothes
3. Speeding 16-20kmph over the limit	20	\$120 New shoes
Driving after hours / carrying passengers	35	\$100 (cost of learners license)
5. Blood alcohol level up to 30mg per 100ml	50	\$200 GO Pro
6. 30-minute parking ticket	0	\$15 Hunger Buster
7. Parking on or near a pedestrian crossing	2	\$60 Make-up
