Activity Name: Post-it Pledge

Principle:

Sober drivers

Safe speeds

No distractions

Avoiding risks

Driving to the conditions

Building experience

Summary: As a SADD committee, create A3 pledges for your school community - "I pledge to...". Encourage students to write on a post-it note one safe driving habit they will commit to, to sign their name, and put on the pledge.

The purpose is to promote discussion from students about their driving decisions and behaviour and get them to make a commitment. Display your message around the school in different ways such as posters, social media or a video.

Sample pledges:

I pledge to say no to passengers on my restricted

I pledge to not pick up my phone while I am driving

Notes:

- Consider which SADD principles are relevant to your school and community and use this to inspire your pledges
- It is effective to use multiple methods to share your message i.e. visual posters, digital messages, school notices, etc.
